The **Museum of the Southern Jewish Experience**, a department of the **Goldring/Woldenberg Institute of Southern Jewish Life**, seeks a talented and energetic college sophomore, junior or senior for an exciting, educational, and diverse internship experience in Mississippi.

Our intern will primarily be working within the museum's collection to research, design and curate a new online exhibition.

Duties may include:

- Researching, designing and formatting content for a new online exhibition about the Southern Jewish Experience featuring items from the collection.
- Updating collection records to include descriptions, photographs and condition.
- Accessioning new donations using appropriate conservation techniques.
- Other projects may include presenting educational programs, research on museum media innovation and heritage tourism or developing a traveling exhibit.

A strong applicant will have an interest in southern and Jewish history and have the ability to produce engaging written content for a general audience.

Candidates that have familiarity with standard archival practices, web design or experience creating online content should also apply.

Interns will reside in Jackson, Mississippi and receive a stipend. The internship runs from June 4 to August 10, 2012. The Institute will help locate lodging, though interns will be responsible for paying room and board.
